The pig has been procured, tents and supplies will be delivered to the lot by Ashton Boyer, and there will be a quick set up at 10 on Saturday morning.

**Butterfly Project**: It was suggested/requested that PIE begin to research a project for purchasing milkweed plants that were an appropriate and proven food source for the Monarch butterflies. Ray Smith is researching the project.

**Tree Project**: Dick Sadenwater will be getting the trees that were ordered and is in the process of finding a good way to distribute them to PIE members who have signed up for them.
