#### **Action - Linda Cotherman**

- Conservancy Act -
  - The Conservancy Bill has been filed HB4077 and assigned to the first of three committees.
  - Getting a quote from LGIPA Attorney for lobbying
  - o LGIPA is doing a call to action and we may soon send out our own.

#### Social - Kelly Lube

- Palm Palooza went really well.
  - Cost was \$500 and a big success

  - We had a low turn out, possibly related to location or movie choice. May discontinue this event next year. Although it's a very easy, low cost event. Maybe do it in the common lot on North Gulf where people can see it getting set up.

#### Info Central - Susanne Stubbs

- Conservation District Act
  - ~45 people attended
  - Danny Nix was impressed with the turnout and did a good job
  - It seemed like it helped connect people and make them feel heard today and tomorrow. It also helped people to understand the bill.
- Not doing one in March, but potentially looking at a few options for April
- Partner with BICI for Dark Sky Info central
- Combine a Right of Way Info central with beach renourishment

# Island Watch, Roads & Bridges, Barrier Island Fire District - Linda Cotherman

- Potentially change the name of this committee because this is really a reporting to PIE of these other groups that potentially impact our island.
- Right of Way:

- In the Dec Commission meeting, they discussed making us a special district for what we do in the right of way.
- Roads and Bridges is recommending phased launch, first 10 ft off the edge of the pavement. Any homeowner should remove any hardscape. On N and S Gulf, there are 5 beach easements. If there's not enough parking (50 spots near each public beach access) we don't get much funding for beach renourishment.
- Neighborhood plan this is going out for bid again to be updated, which means it's
  advertised and sent to all the engineers and contractors the county can work on it.
  Ultimately have the commissioners approve it.
- **Speed limit** March 28th meeting to present the lowered speed limit to the commissioners. All sand roads and N. Gulf from the ferry landing to the bridge will be 15mph. From the bridge to the resort will be 20 mph.
  - May need letter writing or in person meeting. TBD.
- Fire District last meeting cancelled
- Paving Panama Blvd is planned. We are keeping an eye on this to advocate for how
  this should be done. And to see if the county would consider re-striping it, taking back
  the easement, making appropriate parking, making a walkway, etc.
  - Action: Linda to get more info on the timeline and what we can do
- Street Lights Carol, new head of Turtle Watch, will advocate for the further in street light to be turned off. Terry Miklos is very upset and wants it turned off because it shines into his bedroom.
  - Action: Linda to connect with Terry
- Beach Renourishment no update
- Flag Pole Area: all replanted and pretty
- Dead Fish Danny Nix to look into that
- **FEMA** has not brought the sifter in because they are waiting for the birds.
- New trees planted on N. Gulf at the request of the homeowner. They are in the right of way and are being done without a permit.
