Action - Linda Cotherman

- Neighborhood Plan
 - On the 24th, the County is selecting an engineering firm to oversee the project
 - The county plans to host open meetings where the public can go to be a part of the update of the community plan.
 - The original was written primarily by Meryl. The Action Committee, chaired by Linda, will form a new group (doesn't need to be the same as the sewer committee) and re-write it by surveying the community interests to best advocate for our island.
 - Starting this Wednesday, we have four weekly emails to go out about this project and what's coming up. Then we are doing a series to collect public insight - likely via polls.

- The sandcastle contest on the 4th of July was a hit, once again. Here are a few numbers to show the general demographic in attendance.
 - We had 19 groups of people "sign-in" accounting for over 60 people. That being said, we easily had about 80 people come through.
 - ~80% of attendees were 10 years old or older.
 - ~60% of attendees were over 20 years old.
 - Here is the breakdown of the ages.

 - 12 11-20yr
 - 5 21-30yr
 - 3 31-40vr
 - 7 41-50yr
 - 1 1-30yi

 - **8** 60+
